Subject: Report of Day-2 (17.12.2024) on celebration "Swachhta Pakhwada" by ICAR-IIWM, Bhubaneswar - reg

The 2<sup>nd</sup> day was celebrated as the 'Swachhta Awareness Day' as per the guidelines for mass awareness and sensitization on swachhta theme at one of the MGMG-adopted villages, Pampalo of Balipatna block in Khordha district. Above fifty villagers including women and youths enthusiastically participated in the programme. At the outset, all the participants were administered Swachhta pledge in local language. The participating scientists and staff of the Institute sensitized the villagers on the objectives of the Swachhta Pakhwada, importance of cleanliness on good mental & physical health, elimination of open defecation, safe ways of disposing biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes and adverse impact of rampant use of single use plastic bags on the environment. Scientists also advised the participants to convert biodegradable wastes to wealth through compost making and to make collective efforts to keep the village clean for bringing about an improvement in the general quality of life of people.

In order to achieve the objectives of the *Swachh Bharat* Mission through community participation, a fortnight long 'Signature Campaign' was also started from the village. Later, a special cleanliness drive was undertaken inside the Lord Balunkeswar Shiv Ji's temple premises with the active participation of all villagers.
